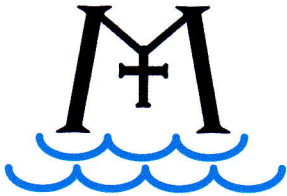


MOZAMBIQUE DEVELOPMENT IN MOTION



Dear Donor,

On June 8, 2011 the IRS revoked the tax exempt status of 279,599 non-profit organizations. Unfortunately, Mozambique Development in Motion (MDiM) was one of the 279,599 organizations who were not in compliance with IRS regulations. As a result, we received written notification from the IRS on December 19, 2011 that our tax exempt status had been revoked. **All donations received prior to December 19, 2011 per guidance from the IRS are tax deductible (www.irs.gov/charities).**

We have requested re-instatement of our tax exempt status which we are confident will be received. We also expect to be notified by the IRS that all donations made in 2012 will be tax exempt. **However, please be advised that until such time we cannot provide an assurance that your donation will be tax deductible.** Should you choose to withhold your donation until we can provide an assurance of our tax exempt status, please notify us. **We will continue to keep our web site updated regarding our tax exempt status (www.mdim.org).**

Non-compliance was an oversight, and our Board of Directors took action immediately. We have already implemented recommendations from the IRS to ensure this does not happen again.

We plan to continue the projects we have underway despite the challenges this situation presents. We recognize that asking for your support now requires an even higher level of faith and commitment and for that we humbly express our deep gratitude. Inhambane Province remains one of the poorest provinces and Mozambique one of the poorest countries in Africa. We know we are making a difference and with God's grace and your help we will continue to do so.
